More than 11,000 people have been killed and thousands injured by a huge earthquake which struck southeastern Turkey, near the Syrian border, in the early hours of Monday morning. The 7.8 magnitude earthquake, which hit near the town of Gaziantep, was closely followed by numerous aftershocks - including one quake, which was almost as large as the first.

The death toll is expected to keep rising as Dr. Carmen Solana, reader in volcanology and risk communication at the University of Portsmouth, said: «After 48 hours, the chances of finding survivors will decrease enormously."

The International Rescue Committee (IRC) has provided assistance to the affected populations across both Turkey and Syria including provision of immediate cash, basic items such as blankets and towels, and hygiene supplies like soap and toothbrushes. Moreover, many countries, including Algeria, have begun to provide humanitarian assistance, mainly water, food and rescue teams. The intervention of the Algerian rescue units led to the rescue of 11 people from under the rubble, and the recovery of 26 dead people.
